

Aims of the Camp

Each of those teams won 27 games which are school records for wins. Trader was recognized as District or Conference Coach of the Year five separate times and was honored in 1988 as the Omaha World Herald's State College Coach of the Year.

In 2007-2008, Coach Trader helped guide the Hastings St. Cecilia team to a 22-2 record and a State Championship.

Location & Facilities

Mike Trader's Mid-America Basketball Camps Individual Sessions will be held for overnight sessions at Doane University (Crete, NE) with Day Camps at Grand Island Central Catholic, Sidney High School, Norfolk YMCA and Hastings Middle School. Campers for the overnight sessions will be housed in air-conditioned dormitories with professional supervision provided. All meals will be served by the regular college food service.
